COVID-19 EMT Re-Entry Process

April 15, 2020

This memo will address the Waiver/Modification of N.J.A.C. 8:40A-7.6 – Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) Expired Certifications from April 7, 2020. The waiver allows a medical director of an agency to apply guidelines on how this shall be managed.

The following process shall apply if an agency wishes to use this waiver:

- 1. The EMT candidate must have expired between April 1, 2015 and April 1, 2020.
- 2. The EMT candidate must apply at www.njems.us as required in the waiver.
- 3. The Chief of the organization should write an endorsement letter.
- 4. The EMT candidate must have and provide a valid CPR certification.
- 5. The EMT candidate must ride as a third crew member for 24 hours with an officer of the organization, and during that time:
 - a. Complete the written assessment currently in place for new hire applicants.
 - b. Complete a trauma scenario-based skill assessment practical rendered by an EMT-Instructor.
 - c. Complete a medical scenario-based skill assessment practical rendered by an EMT-Instructor.
 - d. Review guidelines, medical protocols, and documentation standards for the organization.
- 6. Once completed paperwork is returned to EMSCS, Dr. Stiefel will sign an endorsement letter and submit to the state as a package.
- 7. The organization and EMS Consulting Services have the documentation to support the requirements of the waiver.
